

## Outdoor Amenities

### Base Lake

A 113-acre lake and 70-acre park available to the Offutt community. The lake is stocked annually. A Nebraska state fishing license and a Base Lake permit are both required. The Pavilion rental hall and four covered shelters can house picnics.

### CAST-A-WAYS Boathouse

The Boathouse serves as the Outdoor Recreation office and reservation center during the summer months, and provides boat rentals, bait, snacks, internet access, and area information. Open May 1 – Sept 30.

### Equipment Rental

A wide selection of automotive, boating, camping, catering, childcare, craft, household, gardening, and party equipment for rent. Located on the south end of the base.

### FamCamp

40 campsites at the Base Lake, with sewer, water, and electric hookups. Ten sites have 30-amp service; 30 have both 30- and 50-amp services. There are unlimited spaces to tent camp. Cost: \$16 / night with sewer, water, and electric.

### Horse Stables

32 stables are available for horse boarding, including a hay barn, a tack room, a circle pen, automatic water, grain storage, indoor and outdoor riding arenas, and a pasture. Cost: \$130 / month / horse,.

### Outdoor Adventure Programs

OAP offers recreational opportunities to the Base populace—everything from canoeing to sporting events to family fun days!

## Outdoor Amenities

### Paintball Course

A speed ball course located at the Base Lake, open by reservation. Perfect for large groups, team-building events, and parties.

### RV Storage Lot

Storage is available for privately-owned recreation vehicles. Coordination is done at the Equipment Rental facility on base. Cost: under 30 ft, \$20 / month; over 30 ft, \$25 / month; paid in 6-month intervals.

### Swimming Pools

Offutt houses four swimming pools: an indoor fitness pool at the Offutt Field House, an airmen's pool, and two outdoor seasonal pools. Aquatic programs include water aerobics and swimming lessons.

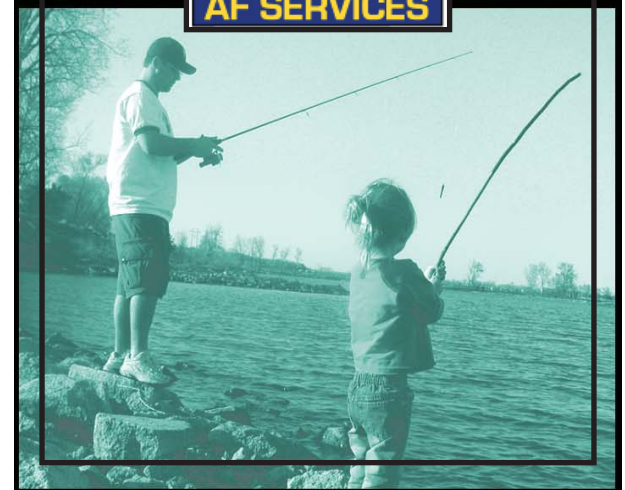

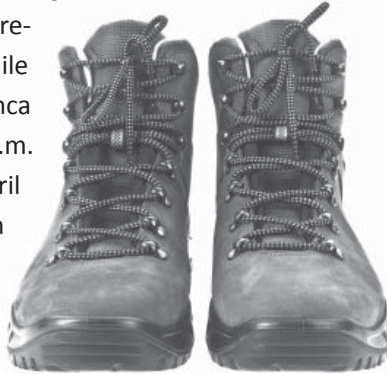

The CAST-A-WAYS Boathouse will open for the season on May 1. The outdoor swimming pools will open on May 23.

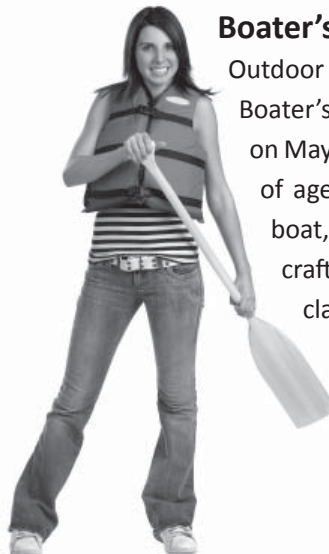
### Adventureland Park Trip
