MEMORANDUM FOR ALL OFFUTT AFB DINING FACILITY CUSTOMERS

SUBJECT: Dining Facility Customer Eligibility Policy

1. The following customers are authorized to eat at the Campisi Alert and Ronald L. King dining facilities in addition to those already authorized per AFI 34-239, *Food Service Management Program*.

- a. U.S. Military members (officers or enlisted), DoD civilians and Foreign military members while on TDY status to Offutt AFB – if their TDY orders authorize use of dining facilities.
- b. Active Duty, to include officers and enlisted, and their family members on federal holidays, Easter and the Air Force Birthday.
- c. Fire Department civilians will be authorized to eat in the dining facility when assigned to an authorized shift or in the event of emergency.
- d. All Commanders assigned to the wing, Wing Inspector General, the Force Support Squadron Deputy, Sustainment Services Flight Commander, Food Service Officer, and Chaplains are authorized to eat in the dining facility for the purpose of evaluating the service rendered. Evaluation visits should be varied to include evenings and weekends. Customer comment cards should be filled out and placed in the comment boxes located in the front dining area.
- e. Spouse and dependent children of active duty members E-1 to E-4.
- f. Retirees are authorized to use the facility when there is no impact in serving primary customers.
- g. DoD civilians are authorized to use the facility when there is no impact in serving primary customers.
- h. Guests of Essential Station Messing (ESM) member only during birthday meal celebration, while accompanied by the member, limited to one guest (non-immediate family) per visit and any immediate family members.
- i. Members and chaperones of organized nonprofit youth programs (as defined in AFI 34-239) sponsored at either the national or local level when extended the privilege of visiting Offutt AFB. Authorization must be in writing and approved by the 55 FSS/FSV or designated representative.

2. All food is intended to be consumed in the dining facility during applicable meal periods, except where ground support meals, carry-out, or Grab-n-Go services are offered.
