SUBJECT: Ronald L. King Dining Facility Customer Eligibility Policy

1. The following customers are authorized to eat at the Ronald L. King dining facility in addition to those already authorized per AFI 34-239, *Food Service Management Program*.

- a. Military members and DoD civilians TDY to Offutt if orders authorize use of dining facilities.
- b. Foreign military members on TDY orders which state authorization to use dining facilities.
- c. Fire Department civilians when assigned to an authorized shift or in the event of emergency.
- d. Wing Commander, Vice Wing Commander, Wing Inspector General, Group Commanders, Deputy Group Commanders, Squadron Commanders and designated persons, 55 FSS Deputy, Chaplains, and 55 FSS Sustainment Services Flight leadership are authorized for the purpose of evaluating quantity and quality of food served.
- e. Retirees, if there is no impact in serving primary customers. Dependents of retirees may dine on federal holidays, Easter, and the Air Force Birthday.
- f. Spouse and dependent children of active duty E-1 to E-4 may dine on weekends.
- g. Active duty, officers and enlisted, and their family members on federal holidays, Easter and the Air Force Birthday.
- h. Officers, during official functions or meetings such as CGOC, DV luncheons, etc.
- i. Members and chaperones of organized nonprofit youth programs (as defined in AFI 34-239) sponsored at either the national or local level when extended the privilege of visiting Offutt AFB. Authorization must be in writing and approved by 55 FSS/FSV or designated representative.

2. All food is intended to be consumed in the dining facility during applicable meal periods, except where ground support meals, carry-out, or Grab-n-Go services are offered.

3. Refer to AFI 34-239, Atch 2, for a complete list of eligible customers and their charges. Point of contact in this matter is the Food Service Officer at DSN 271-6616.
