Greetings,



Congratulations on your assignment to Offutt AFB, gem of the Midwest and one of the best assignments in the Air Force! I have included some important information about the school options available for your children; public, private, and homeschooling. Our base provides some of the finest services in the Air Force – if you are looking for childcare, family friendly events, support services, please visit the 55th FSS website at <u>https://www.offutt55fss.com/</u> for lots of great information!

There are over 20 public school districts located in the Omaha metro area as well as in Council Bluffs and Glenwood Iowa. The two largest districts educating our military youth are Bellevue Public Schools and Papillion LaVista Community Schools. These districts fall under the guidance of the Nebraska Department of Education – there are no DoD Schools in the state of Nebraska. We are not a school choice state, your district is determined by your address although you have a chance to Option Enroll in different districts when there is space availability. School district boundaries do not align with city boundaries, please contact me if you have a question about which district you will attend.

Immunization Information

Regardless of where you enroll, Nebraska law requires that all students entering prekindergarten, kindergarten or seventh grade have a physical exam prior to the start of the school year. Exams must have been completed within the last six months of the first day of school (or day of enrollment for new families). <u>Physical exams are also required for students transferring</u> <u>into any grade level from schools outside of the state</u>. The physical may be completed by any physician either in the state or outside of the state as long as the form is filled out.

Advance Enrollment Policies

In 2019, Nebraska has passed legislation for advance enrollment of military families if they meet the criteria. The school board shall permit children of military families to enroll preliminarily in a school district if a parent presents evidence of military orders that the military family will be stationed in this state during the current or following school year. A student of a military family shall be admitted to the school district without charge upon arrival in Nebraska if the requirements are met.

With advance enrollment, you will not get to pick the specific school and will be assigned a school based upon your address once you arrive. If the district you completed advance enrollment with is not zoned for your address, you will have to complete option enrollment if you wish to attempt to stay in that district.

Option Enrollment Policies

Parents may choose to opt to enroll into a <u>district</u> of their choosing. If the district grants option enrollment, the district will then choose the school for the student. Some districts may ask for a preference list or additional support for selecting the district such as childcare needs.

The window for option enrollment applications is September 1 through March 15 for the following and subsequent school years.
